# WHAT TO EXPECT

## SUNSET SELF-DRIVE SAFARI

### **15:00 - 16:00:**

Pick-up from hotel/residence

(time will be confirmed directly with you the day before/on the day of the experience)

### **16.30:**

Arrival in the Dubai Desert Conservation Reserve

### **16.45 - 17.10:**

Briefing and instruction on reserve/off-road driving

### **17.10 - 18.00:**

Off-road drive to camp (self-drive or guided safari based on the chosen option)

### **18.00 - 19.00:**

Snacks and refreshments will be served at the campsite

### **19.00:**

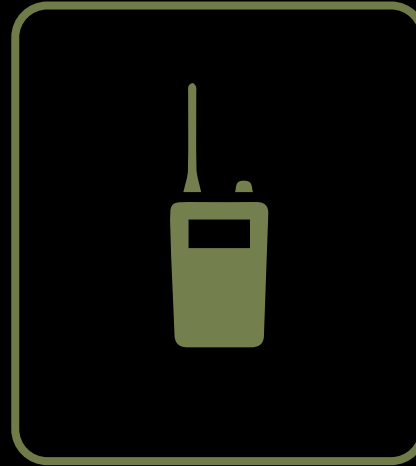
Departure from camp



A valid UAE driving license or international driving license is required to participate in the self-drive adventure and to be presented to your guide\*



The credit card used for booking must be shown to your guide at the time of pick-up for the experience\*



Handheld radios will be distributed to each car to ensure communication and guidance throughout the experience



We have two western toilets on site

**Failure to present these documents means that the experience will be guided (vehicle operation and safari conducted by guide) rather than self-drive**

## CLOSED SHOES

Closed-toe shoes to be worn at all times by all participants

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# CAMP RULES



The speed limit inside the DDCR is 40 kilometres per hour. Adherence to this limit is mandatory for your own safety, the safety of those inside the vehicle you are driving and that of the animals in the reserve.



No littering! Black plastic bin bags are provided. Please place all rubbish in these bags in order to protect the natural beauty of our campsite for future guests. Please remember we are within a protected natural reserve.



If you are at the campsite with other groups, please be mindful of the noise.



During the cooler months, wear warm clothes as temperatures in the desert can get cooler than in the city.



We prefer the sounds of nature, but if you choose to bring a speaker for music, please keep it at a volume that only your group can hear.
